## **JBBBS & WELLS FARGO REACH OUT TO L.A. YOUTHS AT CAMP MAX STRAUS**

GLENDALE -- Jewish Big Brothers Big Sisters of Los Angeles (JBBBS) and Wells Fargo employees reached out to approximately 1,000 under-served youths throughout Los Angeles on Sunday through Camp Max Straus to provide support and scholarships.

Sunday marked Visitor's Day at Camp Max Straus, a residential camp that hosted the youths, wherein JBBBS partnered with Wells Fargo employees and spent the day visiting with campers and worked on improvement projects throughout the camp.

A special Arnold S. Nelson Scholarship ceremony was also held for a selected group of young adults who have completed the Camp Max Straus backpacking and leadership development programs in the High Sierras, called the Witherbee Program.

JBBBS, which has provided scholarships to over 40 children through its various programs in 2007-- bringing the total to more than \$120,000 in financial assistance, annually offers Arnold S. Nelson Scholarships to motivated and deserving youths who have completed the Witherbee Program based on the scholar's needs, ability to succeed and commitment to community service.
