JBBBS Hosts Lifetime Achievement Awards

More than 800 people recently attended the Jewish Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Los Angeles' (JBBBS) Lifetime Achievement Award Dinner at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel.

The evening honored the Silvers with the Sydney J. Rosenberg Lifetime Achievement Award, and Sig Diamond as Big Brother of the Year. More than \$700,000 was raised at the event, which was also a fundraiser for JBBBS. Marey Schulman, who won a drawing for a Mercedes-Benz, donated the car back to the organization for an impromptu raffle that within moments raised \$18,000.
